Amongst its Malinois foundation stock, **Nordenstamm Kennel** imported the much celebrated **Zico v.d. Berlex Hoeve** IPO3, SchH3, FH2. Zico was no 3 at the 2003 FCI Championships and no 2 at the 2004 Belgium National Championships and no 3 at the 2004 Belgium Malinois Championship.

Zico is a son of the legendary **Turcodos v.d. Duvetorre** IPO3, and considered one of his best progeny. Zico's dam, **Sanka v.d. Berlex Hoeve** IPO3, was a five time contender at the World Championships and is herself a daughter of the FCI World Champion, Lex IPO3.

Reporting on the 2003 FCI World Championship, the German working dog magazine, Der Gebrauchshund, page 18/4/2003, had the country's leading dogsport commentator, Jurgen Rixen, critiquing Zico as follows; "Third place went to the Malinois, Zico v.d. Berlex Hoeve. A magnificent dog! With 99 points in the tracking and 96 points in the obedience, the 3 year old male was ready to start the protection work. Dominant guarding and powerful strikes with firm grips are the hallmarks of this male. In addition, came a textbook counter-bite before the Out, and a good obedience. In the long escape, Zico did not hit, he SMASHED in - a cannon ball couldn't have flown any faster! Ninety six points! In a small glimpse from the past: During the World Championships for Malinois in 2000 in Homburg, the Helpers at the trial awarded a trophy to the dog which they thought was the best one. They selected **Turcodos v.d. Duvetorre**, the sire of **Zico v.d. Berlex Hoeve!**"

The depth of quality in the kennel's female foundation stock is equally as strong. Beginning with Zico's dynamic full sister, **Zita v.d. Berlex Hoeve** IPO3, SchH3, FH - bred before her departure from Belgium to the 3 times World Champion, **Yagus v.d. Duvetorre** IPO3, and successfully again in Australia, via frozen semen, to Danish FMBB participant, Daneskjold Aragon IPO3.

By 2007 the Yagus/Zita progeny were in the trial rings and **Nordenstamm Malinois** attending the 2007 Australian National Schutzhund Trial (judged by Japanese and SV Judge, Haruo Masuda - a two times World Champion) won National High in Trial awards for High-in-Trial Obedience - **Nordenstamm Hassan**, and High-in-Trial Tracking - **Nordenstamm Halina**. The same year **Zita v.d. Berlex Hoeve** won Queensland State Champion, followed by her winning 2008 State Champion the following year.

At the 2007 Gold Coast Sportdog Club's Spring Trial, Nordenstamm-bred dogs won overall High-in-Trial - **Nordenstamm Hannah**, as well as High-in-Trial Tracking - **Nordenstamm Hannah**, High-in-Trial Obedience - **Nordenstamm Halina**, Best BH - **Nordenstamm Genesis**, and High-in-Trial Protection - **Nordenstamm Hassan**, with Hassan and handler Ben Geurts, earning a previously unprecedented, Australian-first of 100 POINTS IN PROTECTION!

As well as demonstrating their prowess in sporting events, these dogs progeny are also making their mark in other areas; in detection, in the military, in the correctional services and security industry, as well being in demand for inclusion in other breeder's programs, both here in Australia and abroad.

In 2008 our Malinois made their mark in both the conformation and the trial ring, including the 2008 Australian Grand National Champion & National High-In-Trial Obedience, **Nordenstamm Hassan**, SchH3; plus the 2008 National H.O.T. Champion & National High-In-Trial Protection, **Nordenstamm Hannah**, SchH3; **Nordenstamm Ilana** - winner of Best BH at 2008 National; and **Nordenstamm Halina** getting her SchH3 title. In the show ring, **Nordenstamm Kalinka** won Baby Puppy of Breed at the Gold Coast Championship Show in May, followed by **Nordenstamm Kastr**a winning Puppy Bitch, Challenge Bitch and Best of Breed at the August Gold Coast Championship Show.

Frozen semen from proven, top European Malinois stud dogs is also available to discerning breeders.
